Program

June 22nd

Leaving from Florence at 10 am (airport of railway station) on the 22nd of June. Lunch at Larderello. The Geothermics Museum and the 60 MW geothermal plants. Hotel in the surrounding area of Larderello

June 23rd

Visit to the Monterotondo and Sasso Pisano hydrothermal (degassing) areas. Lunch between Larderello and Abbadia San Salvatore. The geothermal field of Monte Amiata and visit to the Bagnore geothermal field. The Bagnore geothermal park and the geothermal plant. The binary cycle geothermal plant. The AMIS (abatement device for H₂S and Hg). Hotel at Abbadia San Salvatore

June 24th
