

PARTIAL MELTING & CRUSTAL DIFFERENTIATION: MIGMATITES AND GRANITES OF NORTH-SARDINIA

The Variscan basement of Sardinia exposed along the north-eastern coast of the island, shows interesting outcrops of igneous- and sedimentary-derived **migmatites** and **granites** emplaced during the Middle Carboniferous to Permian post collisional phase of the orogeny.



PROGRAM

Day one: we will leave Cagliari in the morning of Sunday the 22nd of June and visit **Porto Ottiolu**, along the north-eastern coast of Sardinia. The participants will observe igneous and sedimentary-derived migmatites and their relationships at the outcrop scale. In the nearby **Punta de Li Tulchi** bay we will visit the most interesting outcrop in Sardinia of mafic rocks, with relics of eclogite-facies mineral assemblage.

Day two: we will visit the amphibolebearing migmatites of **Punta Sirenella** and discuss their formation. Then we will visit the eclogites of **Terrata** (Golfo Aranci) and then move toward north to the **Barrabisa** granitic complex on the northern coast.

Day three: the participants will have the possibility of visit a spectacular outcrop of low pressure migmatites of **Punta Bianca** which underwent melting in presence of water. Bring a swimming costume!
